January 15, 2017 – 0723 hours

Officers were dispatched to Sheffield Drive on the report of a traffic hazard. Upon arrival, officers located a water main break. The officers stood by until the Bellbrook Service Department arrived on scene.

January 15, 2017 – 1629 hours

A resident on Bellbrook Woods Court reported that she had mailed a check to a business in Cincinnati and that it had been intercepted and was cashed by an unknown subject. The complainant's bank was notified and they are investigating the case.

January 16, 2017 – 2057 hours

An officer was dispatched to Mill Pond Drive where a female locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

January 17, 2017 – 1248 hours

An officer was dispatched to Periwinkle Drive where a subject had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

January 18, 2017 – 1522 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. A 32-year old male passenger in the vehicle was wanted on a warrant from the Xenia Police Department. He was not wearing a seat belt at the time of the stop. The suspect was taken into custody and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for No Seat Belt. He was then turned over to an officer from the Xenia Police Department.



January 18, 2017 – 1635 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Upper Bellbrook Road for an equipment violation. Upon contact with the 22-year old driver from Beavercreek the officer could smell an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The suspect turned over marijuana along with drug paraphernalia upon questioning. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and two counts of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

January 18, 2017 – 1912 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. The 54-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Reinstate License and Two Brake Lights Required.

January 19, 2017 – 2249 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department on Ferry Road with a suspicious activity report. The complainant advised seeing someone shining a flashlight on his property. Officers searched the area but did not locate anyone.

January 20, 2017 – 0008 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on South Main Street on an intrusion alarm activation. The business was checked without any signs of criminal activity.

January 20, 2017 – 0219 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located an open service door to a garage on Little Sugarcreek Road. Contact was made with the homeowner who locked the door.

January 20, 2017 – 1124 hours

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on Wilmington Pike. The 86-year old driver at-fault from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Yield.



January 20, 2017 – 2344 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Marcia Drive for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 54-year old male driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Failure to Signal.
