**January 22, 2017 – 0205 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located an open garage door on Pinegrove Drive. The homeowner was contacted and the garage door was secured.

**January 22, 2017 – 1516 hours**

A traffic accident was reported on South Linda Drive. The 38-year old driver at-fault from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control.

**January 22, 2017 – 1529 hours**

A resident on Ridgetop Drive reported she was being harassed on social media. A report was taken.

**January 22, 2017 – 2345 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver of the vehicle did not have a valid driver's license. The 32-year old driver from Kettering was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Reinstate.

**January 23, 2017 – 1719 hours**

Officers responded to West Sudbury Drive on an intrusion alarm activation. The residence checked secure. The homeowner was notified.

A resident on Maxwell Drive reported finding a large dent on the hood of her car. The damage was documented for insurance purposes.

A vehicle was stopped on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that a 26-year old male from Bellbrook was wanted on warrants from the Miami County Sheriff's Department and the Dayton Police Department. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition. The driver was given a warning for No Rear License Plate Light.



**January 27, 2017 – 1202 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Woodacre Drive on an intrusion alarm activation. False alarm.

**January 27, 2017 – 1301 hours**

An officer assisted the Kettering Police Department with the execution of a search warrant on Wilmington-Dayton Road. Items that were stolen during a residential burglary in Kettering were recovered.

**January 27, 2017 – 2200 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Maple Leaf Court on the report of a disturbance. Upon arrival officers observed two subjects involved in a verbal argument. A 46-year old male involved in the argument got in his vehicle and attempted to leave. The suspect was found to be intoxicated and taken into custody. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Resisting Arrest. He was transported to the Greene County Jail.

Officers were dispatched to Country Wood Drive to assist the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a large underage party. The officers stood by until no longer needed.
