### **January 29, 2017 – 0230 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located a suspicious occupied vehicle parked on Terrace Creek. Contact with the driver revealed that he had stopped to use his cellular phone.

### **January 29, 2017 – 1306 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Knob Hill Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the homeowner had accidentally set off the alarm.

### **January 30, 2017 – 1637 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Moss Oak Trail on the report of a burglary in progress. Investigation led to the arrest of a 24-year old female from Xenia for Aggravated Criminal Trespassing and Theft, and a 27-year old male from Xenia for Criminal Trespassing. Both subjects were transported to the Greene County Jail.

### **January 31, 2017 – 1323 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for several equipment violations. Investigation revealed that the 43-year old male driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Failure to Reinstate License, and Expired Registration.

### **January 31, 2017 – 1524 hours**

A traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street near North Linda Drive. The driver of a vehicle traveling westbound lost control and struck a traffic sign. The 65-year old male from Centerville was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control.



**February 1, 2017 – 1317 hours**

An officer assisted the Greene County Probation Department on East South Street with the arrest of a 15-year old female for a Probation Violation. The juvenile was taken into custody without any problems.

**February 1, 2017 – 1352 hours**

A traffic accident was reported on Little Sugarcreek Road. A vehicle traveling southbound slowed its speed and was rear-ended by another vehicle. The driver at-fault, a 22-year old female from Dayton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Maintain Assured Clear Distance Ahead.

**February 1, 2017 – 1803 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Kensington Drive on the report of an alarm sounding. Investigation revealed that animals had caused the disturbance. False alarm.

**February 2, 2017 – 0101 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for several equipment violations. Investigation revealed that the 19-year old male driver from Xenia was impaired. He was taken into custody and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Drug Abuse, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Tinted Windows, and a Display of Vehicle Registration violation.

**February 2, 107 – 1501 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Upper Bellbrook Road on the report of an unruly juvenile. The 11-year old child was picked up by his parents.

**February 3, 2017 – 0123 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located an occupied vehicle at Bellbrook Park after closing hours. The 28-year old driver advised he was there to play the Pokemon game. He was told to leave the park.



**February 3, 2017 – 0734 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Old English Circle on the report of a car alarm sounding. Contact was made with the elderly vehicle owner, whom officers assisted with turning off the alarm.

**February 3, 2017 – 1054 hours**

A disorderly subject was reported at a business on West Franklin Street. The business owner asked for the subject to be removed from the premises. The suspect, a 55-year old female from Spring Valley was told to leave the business. The business banned the female from returning in the future.

**February 3, 2017 – 2328 hours**

An officer was dispatched to West Maple Street on a complaint of subjects in the area talking very loud. Upon arrival the officer checked the area but was unable to locate anyone causing a disturbance.

**February 3, 2017 – 2328 hours**

A subject locked his keys in his vehicle on East Franklin Street. An officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

**February 4, 2017 – 0844 hours**

A resident on Sugar Run Trail advised that an envelope with cash was stolen from his mailbox. There were construction workers at the home when the envelope was dropped off. The case has been assigned to a detective.

**February 4, 2017 – 0910 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Mill Pond Drive where a subject locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.



**February 4, 2017 – 2231 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after observing the vehicle swerve outside the lane of travel several times. Investigation revealed that the 57-year old male driver from Dayton was intoxicated. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for 2 counts of Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, and Failure to Stay in Marked Lanes.
