February 5, 2017 – 0236 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after it drove through a red light. Investigation revealed that the 29-year old male driver from Kettering was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for two counts of Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Failure to Obey to a Traffic Control Device.

February 5, 2017 – 0901 hours

Officers were dispatched to Sable Ridge Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Officers made contact with the homeowner and investigation revealed that the alarm system had malfunctioned. False alarm.

February 6, 2017 – 0946 hours

An officer was dispatched to Barnett Drive where an unlicensed wrecked vehicle had been parked in a backyard. The vehicle owner was given 10-days to remove the vehicle from the property. The officer noted that on February 11th the vehicle was no longer at the residence.

February 6, 2017 – 1515 hours

A vehicle was stopped on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the 42-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.



February 7, 2017 – 2036 hours

Officers were dispatched to the area of Ivy Crest Drive and Lakeview Drive on the report of a female waving down vehicles as she was walking. The female was located on Marcia Drive and advised she had been at a family member's home but had decided to leave after she had gotten into a verbal argument. The female told officers she was walking back to her home in Dayton. The female was given a ride to the bus stop at Clio Road and Wilmington Pike.
