March 26, 2017 – 0221 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that a 15-year old male passenger from Fairborn had consumed alcohol. He was taken into custody and cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Underage Consumption and Obstructing Official Business. He was later released to his parent.

March 26, 2017 – 1141 hours

An officer was dispatched to Barnett Drive on a barking dog complaint. The officer only heard the canine bark a few times and made contact with the owner who was advised of the complaint.

March 26, 2017 – 1407 hours

An officer responded to Vemco Drive on a complaint of a dog running loose in the area. The complainant advised that the dog had been outside for several days and that the owner had not been home. Greene County Animal Control responded to pick up the dog. The owner will be cited for Dog at Large and No Dog License.

March 26, 2017 – 2056 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 30-year old male driver from Kettering was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.



March 26, 2017 – 2312 hours

Officers were dispatched to South East Street on the report of an occupied suspicious vehicle. Contact was made with the occupant, a 30-year old female from Bellbrook who advised she was playing the Pokemon Go game.

March 27, 2017 – 0008 hours

Officers were dispatched on a report of suspicious persons in the backyard of a residence on Lakeview Drive. Officers along with the assistance of a Sugarcreek Township Police Officer checked the area but were unable to locate anyone.

A resident on South East Street reported that an unknown subject had showed up at her home and asked to enter the residence. It was learned that the subject was a contractor for a utility company and contracted to perform equipment upgrades.

March 28, 2017 – 2128 hours

Officers were dispatched on the report of a hold-up alarm activation on Bledsoe Drive. The homeowner advised she had accidentally activated the alarm.



March 28, 2017 – 2328 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect, a 22-year old female from Union was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Reinstate Driver's License.

March 29, 2017 – 0018 hours

Officers were dispatched to South Lakeman Drive on the report of an open garage door. Upon arrival the officers entered the garage and found the service door leading into the home was ajar. After officers announced their presence several times the homeowner came out of a bedroom and advised that everything was ok.

March 29, 2017 – 0810 hours

An assault was reported on East South Street. Investigation led to the arrest of a 15-year old female from Fairborn for Assault and Disorderly Conduct. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Juvenile Detention Center.

March 29, 2017 – 1431 hours

A backpack found in some bushes on North Main Street. The owner from Xenia was identified and the backpack was turned over to a Xenia Police Department officer to return the found property.

March 30, 2017 – 1128 hours

Officers were dispatched to Liam Court on a burglary alarm activation. The home checked secure without signs of any criminal activity. The homeowner was notified of the alarm activation.



March 30, 2017 – 2025 hours

A hit-skip traffic accident was reported on Tareyton Drive. The driver at-fault, a 71-year old male from Bellbrook struck a tree after backing out of his vehicle. He then drove off and was located in Sugarcreek Township. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Improper Starting and Backing, and Leaving the Scene of an Accident.

March 31, 2017 – 0338 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on Ryder Court. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. The involved parties were separated and a 50-year old male from Moraine was trespassed from the residence.

March 31, 2017 – 1557 hours

A traffic accident was reported on South Lakeman Drive. A vehicle was struck by another vehicle traveling in the wrong lane. The driver at-fault was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Lane of Travel upon Roadway.

While on routine patrol an officer located a vehicle on West Franklin Street with a door standing open. The owner checked the vehicle and confirmed that nothing had been stolen.
