April 3, 2017 – 1305 hours

An officer was dispatched to South Linda Drive on the report of a traffic hazard. Upon the officer's arrival he located a large amount of glass in the roadway. The Bellbrook Service Department was dispatched to clean the roadway.

April 3, 2017 – 1603 hours

Officers were dispatched to Bledsoe Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure.

April 5, 2017 – 0018 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with checking a business on Wilmington Pike after an open door was found. Employees were found to be in the store after hours. No problem.

April 5, 2017 – 1711 hours

A dog was reported to be running loose in the area of Regent Park Drive. The animal was located and contact was made with the owner who was issued a written warning for Dog at Large.

April 5, 2017 – 1741 hours

An unwanted person was reported on Vemco Drive. The suspect, a 47-year old male from Kettering was criminally trespassed from the complainant's property.



April 6, 2017 – 0350 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a registration and moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 43-year old male driver from Huber Heights did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension. A 45-year old female passenger from Huber Heights was found to be in possession of stolen property, drugs, and drug paraphernalia. The female was arrested and charged with 3 counts of Possession of Criminal Tools and 4 counts of Receiving Stolen Property and transported to the Greene County Jail.

April 6, 2016 – 1106 hours

Officers were dispatched to West Franklin Street on a burglary alarm activation. The exterior was checked and officers located a broken window on the building. A key holder for the property was contacted who advised that the window was old and had been broken. No signs of any criminal activity were found.

April 6, 2017 – 1122 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving two bad checks. The cases are assigned to a detective.

April 6, 2017 – 1415 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle on West Franklin Street near Firebird Drive. The vehicle was pushed from the roadway and temporarily parked in the parking lot of a nearby business.

April 6, 2017 – 1459 hours

A complaint of a subject involved in door-to-door sales was received on Cabernet Way. The suspect was located and was ordered to cease his activity until he obtains a soliciting permit.



April 7, 2017 – 1200 hours

A business on State Route 725 reported finding a purse behind their business. The owner was located, who advised that her purse had been stolen from her vehicle in January while it was parked at a business in Sugarcreek Township. The property was returned to the owner.

April 7, 2017 – 1539 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a traffic crash with injuries at the intersection of State Route 725 and South Lakeman Drive. Officers provided traffic control until no longer needed.

April 7, 2017 – 2206 hours

A 17-year old male reported that he had been involved in an accident in Bellbrook and that the suspect vehicle had left the scene of the accident. Investigation revealed that the juvenile had not been truthful with officers and that he was the suspect in a hit/skip accident that occurred in Beavercreek. The juvenile was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Falsification.

April 8, 2017 – 0038 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 19-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired by alcohol and marijuana. The suspect was arrested and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Defective Muffler. An 18-year old female passenger from Huber Heights had consumed alcohol and was found in the possession of an open container of an alcoholic beverage. The female suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Underage Consumption and Open Container. Both suspects were released to their parents.

April 8, 2017 – 0350 hours

An officer located two juveniles on foot after curfew hours. The juveniles' parents were contacted to pick up their children and advised of the curfew violations.



April 8, 2017 – 1949 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on East Franklin Street. Investigation led to the arrest of a 26-year old male from Bellbrook for Domestic Violence and Assault. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.
