April 9, 2017 – 0053 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Mill Pond Drive for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 47-year old driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

April 9, 2017 – 1321 hours

An officer was dispatched to Justin Court on the report of barking dogs. A warning was issued to the owner for Barking Dogs.

April 9, 2017 – 1457 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street. The driver was given a verbal warning for Speeding. Investigation revealed that a 17-year old male in the vehicle was a reported missing juvenile through the Dayton Police Department. The subject was transported to post and the Dayton Police Department was notified that the juvenile had been located. The juvenile was picked up by his father.

A vehicle traveling northbound on Clearview Drive ran off the right side of the road and into a ditch where it became stuck. The 43-year old driver from Kettering was found to be impaired. He did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Driving under an OVI Suspension, Driving under a FRA Suspension, Driving under a Child Support Suspension, Fictitious Registration, Expired Driver's License, and Seat Belt Required. The suspect was transported to the hospital by Bellbrook Medics.

April 12, 2017 – 1200 hours

An officer was flagged down by a citizen who had found a license plate on West Maple Street. The owner of the license plate was located and the property was returned.



April 12, 2017 – 1439 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on North West Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 22-year old driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court.

April 12, 2017 – 1623 hours

Officers were dispatched to Little Sugarcreek Drive on the report of a large tree stump in the roadway. Officers removed the tree from the roadway.

April 12, 2017 – 1922 hours

A dog was reported to be running loose in the area of Hess Road. An officer located the dog but was unable to catch it. The owner from Upper Bellbrook Road was contacted and was able to retrieve the canine.

April 12, 2017 – 2036 hours

A theft was reported on South Main Street. The complainant advised that someone had stolen a large flower pot. Report taken.

April 12, 2017 – 2315 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business on State Route 725 where a subject had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

April 13, 2017 – 1608 hours

A resident on Woodedge Drive reported that an unknown subject had opened a PayPal account in his name and charged a purchase of over \$600.00 to the account. A report was taken. Paypal is not holding the victim responsible for the fraudulent account charge.

Officers were dispatched to Mill Pond Drive on the report of a highly intoxicated subject lying on the ground. The suspect was arrested for Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication and transported to the Greene County Jail.

April 15, 2017 – 2256 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road after he observed a female known to be wanted on a warrant from the Sugarcreek Township Police Department. The suspect, a 28-year old female from Bellbrook was placed under arrest and custody was transferred to a Sugarcreek Township Police Officer.
