April 16, 2017 – 0027 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on West Maple Street. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. The parties were separated for the evening.

April 17, 2017 – 0001 hours

While on routine patrol, officers located several vehicles that had been egged on Polo Trace Court and North Sheffield Drive. The report is under investigation.

April 17, 2017 hours – 0130 hours

into custody and transferred to the Greene County Jail to await extradition to Montgomery County.

April 21, 2017 – 0101 hours

A vehicle was stopped on State Route 725 for several moving violations. Investigation revealed that the 34-year old male driver from Sugarcreek Township did not have a valid driver's license and was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Driving under Suspension, Reckless Operation, and No Turn Signal. The suspect was released to a relative.

A traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street near Main Street. The 50-year old driver at-fault from New Carlisle was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Stay in Marked Lanes.
