#### **April 30, 2017 – 0101 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a License Plate Obstruction violation. Investigation led to marijuana found inside the vehicle. The 22-year old male driver from Centerville was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and Drug Paraphernalia.

#### **April 30, 2017 – 0224 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Ryder Court on the report of an open front door. Investigation revealed that the homeowner was asleep in bed and a storm had blown open the door.

#### **April 30, 2017 – 0852 hours**

An officer was dispatched to West Franklin Street where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

#### **April 30, 2017 – 1041 hours**
