May 7, 2017 – 0215 hours

An officer responded to a business on State Route 725 on the complaint of an intoxicated subject. The officer located the suspect vehicle and stopped it. Investigation revealed that the 18-year old driver from Waynesville was impaired. The driver was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Possession of an Open Container. Two passengers in the vehicle, an 18-year old male and a 17-year old male from Dayton were charged for Underage Consumption.

May 7, 2017 – 2224 hours

Officers were dispatched to Amy Brook Circle on the complaint of a suspicious vehicle parked in front of a residence. Officers located the vehicle and investigation revealed that the driver, a 17-year old male from Spring Valley was impaired. The suspect was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and three counts of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

May 8, 2017 – 0308 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation led to the arrest of the 24-year old female driver from Centerville for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Drug Abuse, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and No License Plate Light.



May 8, 2017 – 1052 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a burglary alarm activation at a business on Wilmington Pike. Contact was made with an employee who advised he had accidentally set off the alarm.

May 8, 2017 – 2143 hours

A resident on South East Street reported a Theft. The complainant advised that during the overnight hours unknown subject(s) had taken a trailer hitch from his vehicle. There are no suspects at this time.

May 9, 2017 – 0832 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Tampico Trail. The driver at-fault pulled out of her driveway and struck a vehicle traveling on westbound. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Yield.

May 9, 2017 – 1201 hours

An officer was dispatched to South West Street on the report of a traffic hazard. Upon arrival a wire was located in the roadway. The Bellbrook Service Department closed the road until the utility company arrived and reinstalled the wire.

May 9, 2017 – 2332 hours

A resident on Cabernet Way reported hearing footsteps outside of her home. Officers checked the area but did not locate anyone.

May 10, 2017 – 1923 hours

A subject was located drinking alcohol on the sidewalk in front of his residence on West Franklin Street. The subject was told to move onto his property or he could be cited into Court.



May 10, 2017 – 2057 hours

Officers were dispatched to South Belleview Drive on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. The suspect had left the area before the officer's arrival. No charges.

May 10, 2017 – 2113 hours

A burglary alarm activation was reported on Sable Ridge Drive. Investigation revealed that the homeowner had set off the alarm.

May 11, 2017 – 0131 hours

A resident on South East Street reported observing two subjects attempting to climb over his privacy fence. Officers checked the area but did not locate anyone.

May 12, 2017 – 0310 hours

An officer stopped a motorcycle rider on West Franklin Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old male from Centerville was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and a violation of Motorcycle Laws. He was given a warning for a Turn Signal violation.

May 12, 2017 – 0843 hours

An officer was dispatched to Upper Hillside Drive where a subject had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

May 12, 2017 – 1826 hours

An officer was dispatched to Fowler Drive on the report of a juvenile playing basketball in the roadway. Contact was made with the juvenile's parent and the problem was solved by moving the basketball goal into the driveway of the residence.



May 13, 2017 – 0220 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 35-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and a Display of Vehicle Registration violation.

May 13, 2017 – 2118 hours

Officers were dispatched to East Franklin Street on the report of a disturbance. Investigation revealed that a verbal argument had taken place between relatives and had turned into a neighbor dispute when the suspect had stepped outside of the home and was approached by a neighbor. The parties were separated. No charges.
