May 21, 2017 – 0238 hours

A fight was reported in the parking lot of a business on State Route 725. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. All involved parties were sent home. No charges.

May 21, 2017 – 1135 hours

Officers were dispatched to Clearview Court to stand by as a peace officer while a 39-year old male picked up personal property from the residence. Investigation revealed that the complainant was wanted on a warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office. The subject was taken into custody and transferred to a Montgomery County Sheriff's Deputy.

May 22, 2017 – 0347 hours

Officers were dispatched on the report of an impaired driver who had just left a business on State Route 725. The vehicle was located and stopped. The driver, a 21-year old male from Kettering admitted to smoking marijuana. A loaded firearm, drugs, and drug paraphernalia were found inside the vehicle. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Improper Handling of a Firearm in a Motor Vehicle, Drug Abuse, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

May 22, 2017 – 1112 hours

A resident on Wilmington-Dayton Road reported being harassed by phone and through social media. The suspect was spoken with and ordered to cease all contact with the complainant.



May 22, 2017 – 1428 hours

Officers were dispatched to Portage Path on the report of a drug violation. A 36-year old female from Bellbrook was transported to the hospital for a possible drug overdose and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Possession of Drug Abuse Instruments. The suspect was released from the hospital and officers were dispatched back to the residence four hours later on the report of a drug overdose. Bellbrook Medics again transported the female to the hospital.

May 22, 2017 – 1812 hours

An officer was dispatched to Mill Pond Drive where a subject had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

May 24, 2017 – 1223 hours

Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of a business on State Route 725 on the report of a person trying to get into vehicles by checking door handles. Upon arrival the officers checked the area but could not locate the suspect.

May 24, 2017 – 1352 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 26-year old driver from Vandalia did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Loud Exhaust.

May 25, 2017 – 0034 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 after a routine registration check revealed that the 20-year old driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.



May 25, 2017 – 0930 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Belair Circle. The driver at-fault, a 27-year old male from Bellbrook had struck a parked vehicle while backing out of his driveway. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Improper Backing.

May 25, 2017 – 2229 hours

A prowler was reported on West Franklin Street. The resident reported that he had observed a subject wearing all black clothing standing outside his back door. Officers checked the residence and area but were unable to locate anyone.

May 26, 2017 – 0124 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Drug paraphernalia was located inside the vehicle. The 24-year old male driver from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and No License Plate Light.

May 26, 2017 – 0515 hours

Loud noise was reported behind a business on State Route 725. An officer made contact with a construction crew that was fixing a gas leak. The officer returned to routine patrol.

May 26, 2017 – 1538 hours

A private property accident was reported on Upper Bellbrook Road. The driver at-fault had struck a vehicle while backing out of a parking space. The vehicle owners exchanged insurance information. Report taken.

May 26, 2017 – 1649 hours

An officer was dispatched to North Linda Drive where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.



May 26, 2017 – 1716 hours

A trailer license plate was located on West Franklin Street. The license plate was returned to the owner from Warren County.

May 26, 2017 – 1811 hours

An elderly female was reported missing from her home on West Carmella Court. While the officer was taking the report, the missing person called a family member and advised that she was in Kettering but unable to find her way home. Kettering Police Officers located the female and stood by until a family member picked up the female and returned her to her home.

May 27, 2017 – 1521 hours

A hit & run accident was reported at a business on South Main Street. The complainant advised that his vehicle was struck while parked at the business. The responsible party left without reporting the accident. There is no suspect at this time.
