June 4, 2017 – 0157 hours

An officer observed a suspicious vehicle on State Route 725. Contact with the 21-year old driver from Vandalia revealed that the subject was impaired. The suspect admitted to having smoked marijuana and drinking beer after work. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

June 5, 2017 – 0227 hours

A suspicious vehicle was located on Upper Bellbrook Road. Investigation revealed that the 18-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired by marijuana. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Drug Abuse, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

June 5, 2017 – 0537 hours

Officers were dispatched to South Linda Drive on a panic alarm activation. Investigation revealed a false alarm.

June 5, 2017 – 1553 hours

Officers responded to Brewsters Run Court on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed a babysitter had accidentally set off the alarm.

An officer was approached by an intoxicated subject on West Franklin Street. Investigation led to the arrest of a 51-year old male from Bellbrook for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence.

June 6, 2017 – 0922 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect, a 45-year old male from Dayton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

June 6, 2017 – 1602 hours

A resident on Mill Run Lane reported being harassed by an ex-boyfriend. The suspect was located and ordered to have no further contact with the complainant.

June 6, 2017 – 1619 hours

A resident on Sugar Leaf Drive reported that her ex-boyfriend was harassing her. Contact was made with the suspect and he was ordered to cease all contact with the complainant.
