### **June 11, 2017 – 0719 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Mill Pond Drive on the report of a break-in. Investigation led to the arrest of a 46-year old male for Criminal Trespassing, Theft, and Impersonating a Police Officer. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

### **June 12, 2017 – 0429 hours**

Officers were dispatched to North Lakeman Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The building checked secure. False alarm.

### **June 12, 2017 – 1422 hours**

A resident on Brewster's run reported that an unknown person from Chicago had opened a cable and internet account by using the victim's identity. A report was taken to be forwarded to the cable company.

### **June 12, 2017 – 1734 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Hess Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 45-year old male driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, and Seatbelt Required. He was also issued warnings for No Front License Plate and Two Brake Lights Required.

### **June 12, 2017 – 2008 hours**

An officer was dispatched to a business on Wilmington Pike to assist the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with the arrest of a shoplifter. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

A resident on Washington Mill Road reported that an unknown elderly disoriented male had shown up at her residence asking for directions to Fairborn. The male was experiencing some medical issues and was transported to the hospital by the Bellbrook Fire Department.

**June 13, 2017 – 2305 hours**

Officers responded to a business on West Franklin Street on the report of an intrusion alarm. The building checked secure. False alarm.

**June 14, 2017 – 0218 hours**

An officer responded to South Lakeman Drive on a medical alarm activation. Investigation revealed a false alarm.

**June 14, 2017 – 0722 hours**

An officer was dispatched to East Maple Street near South East Street on the report of a suspicious vehicle with a Kentucky vehicle registration. Contact with the driver revealed that he was a utility company employee and waiting for another employee to arrive before commencing work.

**June 14, 2017 – 1337 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Green Meadows Ranch Court on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure without any signs of criminal activity.



**June 14, 2017 – 1847 hours**

A resident on Kensington Drive reported that an unknown vehicle had driven through her yard during the overnight hours leaving damage to her lawn. No suspect at this time.

**June 15, 2017 – 0245 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a Defective Muffler. Investigation revealed that a 29-year old male passenger from Hamilton was wanted on a warrant from the Butler County Sheriff's Office. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

**June 15, 2017 – 1553 hours**

A domestic dispute was reported to have occurred on Sunday, June 12, on Caudell Drive. The suspect, a 44-year old male from Bellbrook was issued a summons to appear in Xenia Municipal Court for Domestic Violence and Assault.

**June 17, 2017 – 0106 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a registration violation. A strong odor of marijuana was detected coming from the vehicle. The suspect, a 20-year old male from Dayton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse. He was issued warnings for Expired Registration and No License Plate Light.

**June 17, 2017 – 0157 hours**

An officer stopped a suspicious vehicle on Bellemeade Drive after it tried to back into a driveway without the vehicle's headlights on. When the suspect observed the officer he tried to take off. Contact with the 19-year old male driver from Centerville revealed that he was impaired. Investigation led to marijuana, prescription medication, and a drug grinder found in the vehicle. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, two counts of Drug Abuse, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.



**June 17, 2017 – 0857 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle on West Franklin Street near South Linda Drive. The officer was able to help the driver move the vehicle out of the roadway.

**June 17, 2017 – 1057 hours**

A license plate was found on Hillrise Circle. The officer located the owner on Wead Place and returned the property to him.

**June 17, 2017 – 1525 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Bellemeade Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival, the homeowner advised she had accidentally set off the alarm.
