July 30, 2017 – 1712 hours

Officers were dispatched to Beryl Drive on a panic alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the alarm system had malfunctioned.

July 30, 2017 – 1722 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business on State Route 725 where a female from Beavercreek had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.
