**August 21, 2017 – 1141 hours**

A resident on Beechwood Drive reported that her vehicle had been scratched while parked in front of her residence during the overnight hours. No suspect information.

**August 21, 2017 – 2044 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old female driver from Waynesville did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Expired Registration, and Seatbelt Required.

**August 21, 2017 – 2052 hours**

Officers responded to Lower Hillside Drive on the report of an unwanted subject. Investigation revealed that the 43-year old male suspect from Bellbrook had an active warrant for his arrest from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. The suspect would not comply with the officers' orders and fought them as they tried to place him in custody. The suspect was arrested, charged with Resisting Arrest and Obstruction of Official Business, and transported to the Greene County Jail.

**August 22, 2017 – 1314 hours**

A resident on Garry Drive reported that an unknown subject had attempted to open a cellular phone account with his information. The complainant was given advice about identity theft.

**August 22, 2017 – 1806 hours**

An Ipad was found on West Franklin Street near North Linda Drive. The owner was located and picked up the property the next day.

**August 23, 2017 – 0106 hours**

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Poston Drive. Upon arrival the officer made contact with the driver who advised he was dropping off a resident who lives on Poston Drive.



**August 24, 2017 – 0125 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation led to marijuana found inside the vehicle. The suspect, a 19-year old male from Franklin was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse.

Officers were dispatched to Creekview Place for a neighbor dispute. All parties involved were spoken to and a resolution was found for the problems they were experiencing with each other.
