**August 27, 2017 – 1031 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road after a routine registration check revealed that the driver, a 44-year old male from Virginia did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, and picked up by a relative from Franklin, Ohio.

**August 27, 2102 hours**

A vehicle was stopped for a Speed violation on West Franklin Street. Upon contact with the driver, the officer could smell an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Further investigation led to drugs and drug paraphernalia located inside the vehicle. The driver, a 24-year old female from West Carrollton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Speed, Drug Abuse, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

**April 28, 2017 – 0712 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Wilmington-Dayton Road for a disabled vehicle in the roadway. The officer provided traffic control until help arrived to move the vehicle from the roadway.

**April 29, 2017 – 2001 hours**
