September 10, 2017 – 0139 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 64-year old male driver from Centerville was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence.

September 11, 2017 – 0031 hours

Officers were dispatched to Upper Hillside Drive on the report of a suspicious subject on a bicycle. The suspect, a 30-year old male from Waynesville was located. Investigation revealed that the bicycle had been stolen from a residence on Upper Hillside Drive. The suspect was found to be impaired and also had an active warrant for his arrest. He was taken into custody on the warrant and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Theft, and Open Container. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

September 11, 2017 – 0906 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business on State Route 725 where a subject from Hudsonville, Michigan had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

September 11, 2017 – 1926 hours

A resident on Hillrise Circle reported an unknown subject had opened bank and credit card accounts in her name. The victim was not being held responsible for the fraudulent charges on the account. Advice was given to protect her from future identity theft.



September 11, 2017 – 1935 hours

Officers responded to Bonniedale Drive on the report of a panic alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the homeowner had accidentally set off the alarm.

September 12, 2017 – 0720 hours

A resident on Shore Drive reported that her unlocked vehicle had been rummaged through during the overnight hours. The only property missing from the vehicle was some loose change.

September 12, 2017 – 1145 hours

A resident on Ridgeway Road reported that an unknown subject had stolen a laptop and purse from her unlocked vehicle. There were several credit cards in the purse that were used at businesses in Bellbrook and Dayton. The case was assigned to a detective.

September 12, 2017 – 0834 hours

A resident on Bellbrook Woods reported that two of her vehicles had been broken into. One vehicle had been unlocked. The suspect had used a landscaping brick to smash the window of the second vehicle and removed two purses, gift cards, and two hundred dollars from that vehicle. The investigation is ongoing.

September 12, 2017 – 0943 hours

A menacing complaint was reported on Sugarleaf Drive. The complainant advised that she has been harassed by a neighbor's relative on multiple occasions. The victim was advised that the suspect would be contacted and ordered to cease his activity.

September 13, 2017 – 0926 hours

An officer was dispatched to Moss Oak Trail on the report of a disabled vehicle in the roadway. The officer was able to assist with pushing the vehicle off the roadway.



September 13, 2017 – 1912 hours

A complaint of subjects involved in door-to-door sales was received on North Sheffield Drive. The solicitors were located and advised that they could not continue their activity without a solicitor's permit. The subjects left the area.

September 13, 2017 – 2047 hours

An officer assisted a female from Dayton who had locked her keys in her vehicle on Portage Path. Entry into the vehicle was gained.

September 14, 2017 – 0205 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on Ryder Court. Investigation led to the arrest of a 32-year old male from Bellbrook for Domestic Violence, Assault, and Possession of Drug Instruments. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

September 14, 2017 – 1306 hours

An assault was reported at a business on State Route 725. The suspect, a 21-year old female from Nevada was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Disorderly Conduct.

September 15, 2017 – 1505 hours

A hit/skip accident was reported on High Street. A vehicle backing out of his driveway was struck by another vehicle. The suspect vehicle left the scene. A report was taken.

September 15, 2017 – 1643 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 after a routine registration check revealed that the driver of the vehicle did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect, a 33-year old female from Centerville was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

September 16, 2017 – 1120 hours

A resident on Wentworth Drive reported a fraud. The complainant advised that he had received a phone call from a subject claiming to be an attorney representing the complainant's



grandson. The caller told the complainant that his grandson had been arrested and needed \$7,500.00 to get out of jail. The complainant sent the money to the caller. When the victim followed up with his grandson from Jamestown a few days later, he learned that he had not been arrested. The money was sent to a location in Virginia. The case was forwarded to the Virginia Financial Crimes Unit for further investigation.
