September 17, 2017 – 0002 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on East Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 18-year old male driver from Centerville was impaired. The driver was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and No License Plate Light. A 17-year old male passenger from Centerville was found in possession of marijuana and a drug scale. The passenger was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Drug Abuse and Possession of Criminal Tools. Both subjects were released to a relative.

September 17, 2017 – 0352 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Wilmington-Dayton Road for equipment violations. Investigation revealed that the 28-year old male driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.
