October 29, 2017 – 0441 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Wilmington-Dayton Road after an officer observed it being driven on two rims. The driver, a 41-year old male from Waynesville was found to be impaired. The suspect was charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Reckless Operation of a Vehicle.

October 29, 2017 – 2127 hours

Three bicycles were found on South East Street. The rightful owners may claim their property after proper identification.

October 30, 2017 – 1616 hours

The suspect was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

An officer was dispatched to the parking lot of a business on West Franklin Street where a female from Hamilton had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.
