**November 5, 2017 – 0159 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a registration violation. Investigation revealed that the 25-year old driver from Huber Heights did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Fictitious Registration.

**November 6, 2017 – 0343 hours**

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with an alarm activation at a business on Wilmington Pike. Investigation revealed that a delivery person had accidentally set off the alarm.

**November 6, 2017 – 1401 hours**

A resident on Vemco Drive reported receiving threatening letters and text messages from a relative. The suspect, a 52-year old male from Bellbrook, was located in Riverside and charged with Aggravated Menacing.

**November 6, 2017 – 1856 hours**

A resident on Hess Road reported that his PayPal account had been compromised and that two payments had been made from his account for approximately \$250.00 each. The bank was contacted and the complainant was refunded half of his money. He was referred to the Mercer County Sheriff's Department to file a report to document the second fraudulent charge.

**November 7, 2017 – 1120 hours**

A complaint of an unruly juvenile was received on East South Street. Investigation led to a 12-year old male being cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Assault and Menacing.

**November 7, 2017 – 1300 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Jacob Hills Court on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the alarm had accidentally been set off.
