**November 12, 2017 – 0827 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Bellemead Drive where a man had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

**November 12, 2017 – 1626 hours**

A traffic accident was reported at the intersection of West Franklin Street and South Linda Drive. The driver at-fault, a 56-year old male from Spring Valley was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Maintain Assured Clear Distance.

**November 13, 2017 – 0202 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the driver, a 47-year old female was impaired. She was found to be in possession of heroin, prescription pills, syringes and a crack pipe. She was also wanted on a warrant from the Dayton Police Department. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Possession of Criminal Tools, and Obstructing Official Business. The driver was transported to the Greene County Jail. A passenger in the vehicle, a 28-year old female from Dayton was wanted on a felony warrant from the Dayton Police Department. The passenger was also found to be in possession of multiple drugs and drug paraphernalia. The passenger was taken into custody and charged with Possession of Criminal Tools, Possession of Drug Abuse Instruments, and Receiving Stolen Property. She was also transported to the Greene County Jail.

**November 13, 2017 – 1426 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Knob Hill Drive where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

**November 13, 2017 – 1756 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle on West Franklin Street near South Linda Drive. The officer stood by to provide traffic control until the vehicle was towed.

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a moving violation. Upon approaching the vehicle the officer smelled a strong odor of marijuana.
