**November 27, 2017 – 1005 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer found a disabled vehicle in the roadway on North Belleview Drive. The officer stood by for traffic control until the vehicle was towed.

**November 27, 2017 – 1346 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 where an elderly male was disoriented and did not know how to get back to his home in Dayton. A relative was contacted who took the man home.

**November 29, 2017 – 1535 hours**

A resident on Maxwell Drive advised she had received a call from a person claiming to be from Readers Digest who told her she had won a new car and \$100,000.00. The complainant was with the instructions of the caller put in touch with a supposed bank representative who accessed her savings account and transferred \$2,600.00 to her checking account. The complainant was told in order to claim her prize she needed to send that money to an address in St. Petersburg, Florida. A relative became suspicious and contacted the Police Department. The complainant's bank was contacted and they were able to stop the transfer of money. The complainant is not out of any money at this time.

**November 29, 2017 – 2247 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer found an open barn door at a facility on West Franklin Street. The contents of the barn appeared to be undisturbed. Contact was made with the owner of the property.

**November 30, 2017 – 0621 hours**

An officer found an open door at a business on State Route 725. The business checked ok. A key holder arrived on scene and re-secured the building.



**November 30, 2017 – 1108 hours**

An officer observed a vehicle with a flat tire in the parking lot of a business on State Route 725. The officer approached the driver to see if any assistance was needed. Investigation revealed that the 35-year female old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. She was also wanted on a warrant from the Moraine Police Department. The suspect was taken into custody and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension. The female was then turned over to a Moraine Police Officer.

**November 30, 2017 – 1533 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Poston Drive on the report of a fight in progress. Investigation revealed that a domestic dispute had taken place which led to the arrest of a 18-year old male. The suspect was taken into custody, charged with Domestic Violence and Assault and transported to the Greene County Jail. A second suspect, a 19-year old male was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Disorderly Conduct by Fighting.

**November 30, 2017 – 2029 hours**

Officers responded to a business on State Route 725 on the report of a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed a custodian worker had accidentally set off the alarm.
