December 18, 2017 – 2131 hours

An unwanted person was reported on Upper Hillside Drive. The complainant reported that she no longer wanted a relative to stay at her residence. A 27-year old male from Carlisle was ordered to leave the residence.

December 19, 2017 – 1019 hours

A suspicious truck was reported in the area of South Lakeman Drive. An officer located the vehicle and the driver told the officer that he was delivering furniture to a home on Brewster's Run Court, but was lost. The driver was given directions.

Contact was made with the resident who was advised of the complaint and told to turn down the music. The resident apologized. No further complaints received.
