December 24, 2017 – 1255 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road. The officer remained on scene to provide traffic control until the vehicle was towed from the scene.

December 24, 2017 – 1506 hours

An officer responded to Cabernet Way to assist the Bellbrook Fire Department with a Fire Alarm. Investigation revealed that the alarm was caused by a smoke detector that had activated in the kitchen due to smoke caused by cooking. False alarm.

December 24, 2017 – 1602 hours

A mountain bike was found on Kensington Drive. It is being kept at the Bellbrook Police Department. The owner may claim the bicycle after proper identification.

December 24, 2017 – 2138 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a traffic accident on Upper Bellbrook Road where a vehicle had slid off the roadway and struck a traffic sign. Officers remained on scene until no longer needed.

December 25, 2017 – 1621 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on West Franklin Street. Investigation revealed a verbal dispute between a father and his daughter had occurred. The parties were separated for the evening. No charges.

December 26, 2017 – 0041 hours

Officers responded to Maxwell Drive on the report of a person knocking on doors. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate anyone.



December 26, 2017 – 1551 hours

A burglary alarm activation was reported on Cabernet Way. Investigation revealed that the homeowner had accidentally set off the alarm.

December 27, 2017 – 1641 hours

Officers assisted the Bellbrook Fire Department by providing traffic control on Nedra Drive where a structure fire was reported. The officers remained on scene until no longer needed.

December 27, 2017 – 1926 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on Sable Ridge Drive. A 16-year old female had assaulted her parents, which led to her arrest for Domestic Violence and Assault. She was transported to the Greene County Juvenile Detention Center.

December 28, 2017 – 1239 hours

An officer responded to Cabernet Way on the report of a panic alarm activation. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised everything was okay. False alarm.

December 28, 2017 – 1737 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a suspicious occupied vehicle in McGee Park. The officer made contact with the occupant, who advised he was trying to get some sleep before going to work.

December 28, 2017 – 1813 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Moss Oak Trail. A vehicle traveling eastbound struck a parked vehicle, causing the parked vehicle to roll 157 feet from the point of impact. The driver at-fault, a 20-year old female from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Control for Failure to Control. Both vehicles were towed from the scene.



December 29, 2017 – 1353 hours

A wallet was found and turned into the Bellbrook Police Department. The owner was located and the property was picked up later in the day.

December 29, 2017 – 1606 hours

A traffic accident was reported at the intersection of Main and Franklin Streets. A vehicle stopped at the traffic light on North Main Street was struck by a vehicle making a right hand turn onto North Main Street from East Franklin Street. Report taken.

December 29, 2017 – 1800 hours

A subject reported that he had accidentally left his wallet at a business on State Route 725 the previous day. When he realized that his wallet was missing he contacted the business but the wallet had not been located or turned in. The complainant was advised to cancel all his credit cards and to keep a close eye on his bank accounts.
