January 14, 2018 – 0045 hours

An officer located three female juveniles on foot on North Main Street. Contact was made with the parent of the females and a curfew violation letter was issued.

January 14, 2018 – 0143 hours

An officer observed a suspicious person walking on West Franklin Street. The officer made contact with the 37-year old male from Englewood, who advised he was waiting for his girlfriend to pick him up in her vehicle. Further investigation revealed that the subject had an active felony warrant for his arrest from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. The suspect was found in possession of a drug pipe. The subject was turned over a Montgomery County Sheriff's deputy.

January 14, 2018 – 0554 hours

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Belair Circle. An officer made contact with the driver and learned that the subject was delivering newspapers.

January 15, 2018 – 1302 hours

Officers were dispatched to Pinegrove Drive on the report of disorderly persons. Investigation revealed that a verbal domestic dispute had taken place. The involved parties had separated prior to the officers' arrival. Report taken.

January 15, 2018 – 1657 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Sugar Run Trail. A parked vehicle was struck after a driver traveling Northbound lost control of his vehicle. The 16-year old driver at-fault from Bellbrook was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Control.

January 15, 2018 – 2318 hours

An officer assisted a subject whose vehicle had run out of gas on West Franklin Street. The officer drove the man to a nearby gas station to get gas and then transported him back to his vehicle.



January 17, 2018 – 1242 hours

An officer was dispatched to Lynlee Drive on the report of a tree trimming company involved in door-to-door sales. The officer located two males and explained to them that they need a solicitor permit in the City of Bellbrook. Further investigation revealed that one of the subjects, a 40-year old male from Springfield was wanted on an active warrant out of Warren County. The suspect was taken into custody and turned over to the Waynesville Police Department.

January 17, 2018 – 2340 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 22-year old male driver from Dayton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

January 18, 2018 – 1404 hours

An officer dealt with a disorderly juvenile on East South Street. A 17-year old male from Xenia was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court with Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest.

January 18, 2018 – 2225 hours

An officer along with many other agencies responded to Wilberforce University to assist officers with multiple fights at their campus. The officer was cancelled while enroute and the scene was under control.

January 19, 2018 – 1245 hours

An officer located an open front door at a residence on South Linda Drive. The residence checked secure without any signs of criminal activity. A key holder was notified.

January 20, 2018 – 0035 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Upon contact with the driver, the officer could smell an odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle. The 24-year old male driver from Centerville was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia



Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Window Tint.

January 20, 2018 – 2050 hours

A theft from a vehicle was reported on East Franklin Street. The complainant advised that he had taken items from his vehicle into his residence. When he returned to his vehicle approximately five minutes later he noticed that the tailgate was down and several electronics were missing. The report is under investigation.
