January 22, 2018 – 1111 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for Expired Registration. The officer located a marijuana pipe inside the vehicle. A 51-year old male from Dayton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

January 22, 2018 – 1412 hours

Officers responded to Jacob Hills Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that construction workers accidentally had set off the alarm.

January 23, 2018 – 1507 hours

A suspicious parked vehicle was reported on Kensington Drive. Contact was made with a homeowner who told the officer the vehicle belongs to a maid service.

January 23, 2018 – 1956 hours

A resident on Ryder Court reported that an unknown subject had rummaged through his vehicle during the overnight hours. Nothing was missing from the vehicle. Report taken.

Officers responded on the complaint of a subject passed out behind the wheel at the intersection of Justin Court and Fowler Drive. The driver was checked by the Bellbrook Fire Department but did not appear to be experiencing any medical problems. Investigation revealed that the 57-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. The subject was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.



January 25, 2018 – 1511 hours

A suspicious vehicle was reported driving through the area of Shadowleaf Drive. An officer made contact with the driver who advised he had gotten lost.

January 26, 2018 – 1425 hours

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on West Franklin Street between Little Sugarcreek Road and Vemco Drive. A vehicle traveling Eastbound on West Franklin Street continued straight as the roadway curved to the left. The vehicle drove through a fence, and struck a tree. The driver, a 67-year old male from Spring Valley, was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control and transported to the hospital for treatment of his injuries.

January 26, 2018 – 2005 hours

An officer responded to Hillrise Circle on the report of a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure without any signs of criminal activity. The homeowner was notified.

January 27, 2018 – 0340 hours

An officer found an open garage door on Ridgeway Road. Contact was made with the homeowner who checked that nothing was missing from the garage and then closed the door.
