**February 25, 2018 – 0119 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on East Franklin Street for a Fight in Progress. Investigation led to the arrest of a 28-year old male from Bellbrook for Assault and Disorderly Conduct. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

**February 25, 2018 – 1834 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect, a 27-year old male from Huber Heights was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

While on routine patrol an officer located an open garage door on South Linda Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who checked the garage to assure that nothing had been taken from the garage. The door was then closed.

**February 27, 2018 – 1824 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Woodacre Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure. A key holder was notified.
