March 4, 2018 – 0153 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 30-year old male driver did not have a valid driver's license. Marijuana and drug paraphernalia were located inside the vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Drug Abuse, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

March 5, 2018 – 0538 hours

An officer responded to Ferry Road to assist the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a burglary alarm. The residence checked secure without any signs of criminal activity.

March 5, 2018 – 2033 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle in the intersection of South Linda Drive and West Franklin Street. The officer made contact with the driver who advised her vehicle ran out of gasoline. The vehicle was moved off the roadway until a relative arrived with gasoline.

Officers were requested to attempt to locate a subject on Weller Drive wanted on an active warrant from the Fairborn Police Department. The 36-year old male resident was located, taken into custody and turned over to a Fairborn Police Officer.

An officer stopped a vehicle that was being driven on the bike path on West Franklin Street. Investigation revealed that the 59-year old male driver from Germantown was intoxicated. The subject was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, and Possession of an Open Container. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

Officers were dispatched to North Regent Park Drive on an intrusion alarm activation. Upon arrival the homeowner advised he had accidentally set off the alarm.

Investigation revealed that the 21-year old female driver from Kettering was impaired. She was taken into custody and cited for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Lane of Travel upon Roadways.

March 10, 2018 – 0459 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on South Main Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 17-year old female driver from Springfield did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Driving under Suspension.

An officer stopped a vehicle on Beechwood Drive for an equipment violation. Alcohol, marijuana, and drug paraphernalia were located inside the vehicle.
