**March 12, 2018 – 1428 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a Speed violation. Investigation revealed that the 47-year old female driver from Miamisburg did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Speed.

**March 12, 2018 – 2048 hours**
