March 25, 2018 – 2139 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 23-year old female suspect from Wilberforce was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving Under Suspension.

March 26, 2018 – 0224 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 44-year old male driver from Dayton was intoxicated. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence.

March 27, 2018 – 0330 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Department with apprehending shoplifters on Wilmington Pike. Two suspects were taken into custody. The officers cleared the scene.

March 27, 2018 – 1104 hours

An officer was dispatched to Clarkston Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure. Contact was made with the homeowner.

March 27, 2018 – 1249 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on Woodedge Drive. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. One of the involved parties was told to leave the residence.

March 27, 2018 – 1555 hours

A vehicle turning onto North West Street from West Walnut Street struck an oncoming vehicle. The driver at-fault, a 32-year old female from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Yield While Making a Left Turn.



March 28, 2018 – 1939 hours

A minor traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street near Little Sugarcreek Road. Two tires had fallen off a dump truck and struck the vehicle behind it. The involved parties exchanged insurance information. Report taken.

March 29, 2018 – 0717 hours

Officers were dispatched to Chelsea Drive on the report of an unruly 17-year old male juvenile refusing to go to school and drug issues. Investigation led to charges filed in Greene County Juvenile Court for Drug Abuse, Possession of Criminal Tools, and Drug Paraphernalia. The juvenile was transported to school.

March 29, 2018 – 1542 hours

Domestic Violence was reported on Shadowleaf Drive. Investigation led to the arrest of an 18-year old male who had been fighting with two siblings. The suspect was charged with Domestic Violence, Assault, Unlawful Restraint, and transported to the Greene County Jail.

An officer was dispatched to Upper Hillside Drive where a female had locked her keys in her car. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

March 29, 2018 – 1609 hours

A soliciting complaint was reported on North Sheffield Drive. A 21-year old male from Cincinnati who was attempting to sell windows by going door-to-door was told to cease his activity. The officer explained that a solicitor permit was required. The subject left the area.

March 30, 2018 – 1613 hours

Officers were dispatched to Knob Hill Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence was checked without any signs of criminal activity. The homeowner was notified.



March 30, 2018 – 1703 hours

Officers were dispatched to Chelsea Drive on a juvenile problem. The resident advised she had come home and found her 17-year old son had broken household items before leaving the residence. She had also located drug paraphernalia. The suspect later returned to the home and was in a verbal dispute with his parent. Officers spoke to the juvenile who was cited into Juvenile Court earlier in the week. Report taken.

March 31, 2018 – 0043 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a Speed violation. Upon contact with the driver, the officer could smell a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. A 19-year old female passenger from Dayton was found to have marijuana in her purse. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse.

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 55-year old male driver from Dayton was impaired. The suspect was arrested and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence.
