April 22, 2018 – 0224 hours

Officers were dispatched to North Field Drive on the report of juveniles that were ringing doorbells and knocking on doors. Eight juveniles were apprehended after attempting to flee on foot. The parents of all juveniles were notified and curfew violations notices were made.

April 22, 2018 – 1812 hours

A resident on Shadowood Drive reported that a tool that he been stored in his driveway had been stolen. Report taken.

April 23, 2018 – 1000 hours

A theft was reported on West Franklin Street. The resident reported that someone had stolen his iPhone and bifocals from his home. The report is under investigation.

April 23, 2018 – 1822 hours

An officer responded to Belair Circle where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entrance.

April 24, 2018 – 0701 hours

A traffic accident was reported on North Main Street. A vehicle failed to yield to oncoming traffic causing a collision. The driver at-fault, a 65-year old male from Spring Valley was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Yield at an Intersection.



April 24, 2018 – 1456 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Main Street after a routine registration check revealed that the 38-year old male driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

April 25, 2018 – 0110 hours
