May 6, 2018 – 0235 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a vehicle stopped in the middle of the roadway on State Route 725. Investigation revealed that the vehicle had broken down. The officer assisted with getting the vehicle off the roadway.

May 6, 2018 – 1540 hours

An officer responded to Washington Mill Road where a female from Miamisburg locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

May 6, 2018 – 2102 hours

Officers were dispatched to Vemco Drive on the report of an aggressive dog. Contact was made with the owner who was advised of the complaint. The owner was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Barking Dog.

May 7, 2018 – 0456 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a burglary at a business on Wilmington Pike. The officers remained on scene until no longer needed.

May 7, 2018 – 1512 hours

Officers responded to East South Street on the report of a disorderly juvenile. Investigation led to the arrest of a 15-year old male from Yellow Springs for Disorderly Conduct by Fighting. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Juvenile Detention Center.



May 9, 2018 – 0947 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business parking lot on State Route 725 where a subject from Bellbrook locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

May 9, 2018 – 1326 hours

Officers were dispatched to North Main Street on the report of a disabled vehicle. The officer was able to help the driver get the vehicle off the roadway.

May 9, 2018 – 1421 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Upon contact with the driver, the officer could smell an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The vehicle was searched and drugs were located. Further investigation revealed that the 22-year old male driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse, Driving under Suspension, No Seat Belt, and Display of Vehicle Registration. A 47-year old male passenger from Dayton was not wearing his seatbelt. He was also cited into Xenia Municipal Court for No Seat Belt.

May 9, 2018 – 1811 hours

A wallet was found at a business on West Franklin Street. The owner from Centerville was located and picked up the property later in the evening.

May 10, 2018 – 0828 hours

A school bus violation was reported on West Franklin Street near North Belleview Drive where a vehicle failed to stop as children were getting on the school bus. The 56-year old male suspect driver was cited into Xenia Municipal Court.

May 10, 2018 – 1806 hours

A complaint of a subject involved in door-to-door sales was received on Upper Hillside Drive. The 20-year old solicitor did not have a permit. He was ordered to cease his activity and given a warning for Soliciting without a Permit.

A domestic dispute was reported on West Maple Street. Investigation led to the arrest of a 17-year old female for Domestic Violence. The suspect was charged into Greene County Juvenile Court for Domestic Violence.
