### **May 13, 2018 – 0250 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old female driver from Centerville was intoxicated. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court with Operating a Vehicle while Under the Influence and Speed.

### **May 13, 2018 – 0835 hours**

Officers arrested a resident on West Franklin Street on an active warrant. Drugs and drug paraphernalia were located at the residence. The 36-year old male was charged with Felony Drug Abuse and transported to the Greene County Jail.

### **May 14, 2018 – 1127 hours**

Officers assisted the Bellbrook Fire Department by providing traffic control during an attic fire on Cedar Court. The officers remained on scene until no longer needed.

### **May 14, 2018 – 1258 hours**

A traffic accident was reported on Upper Bellbrook Road. A vehicle stopped in traffic was struck when the vehicle behind it failed to stop in time. The driver at-fault, a 71-year old male from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Maintain Assured Clear Distance Ahead.



**May 14, 2018 – 1623 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Sugar Maple Place on the complaint of a subject involved in door-to-door sales. The solicitor was located and ordered to cease his activity without a solicitor permit.

**May 14, 2018 – 2022 hours**

An officer responded to Maxwell Drive on the report of a dog running loose in the area. The canine without any tags was located and transported to the Greene County Animal Control shelter in Xenia.

**May 15, 2018 – 0113 hours**

While on routine bicycle patrol an officer located an open rear door at a business on North West Street. Officers checked the building and did not find any signs of criminal activity. They were able to secure the building and lock the door.

**May 15, 2018 – 1340 hours**

Officers provided traffic control as assistance to the Sugarcreek Township Fire and Police Department for a fuel spill on State Route 725. Officers remained on the scene until the situation was under control.

**May 15, 2018 – 1955 hours**

A complaint of a dog running loose on South Main Street was received. An officer was able to locate the dog owner and return the animal.

**May 15, 2018 – 2047 hours**

Officers responded to Fowler Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the resident had accidentally set off the alarm.



**May 16, 2018 – 1610 hours**

A 28-year old male from Kettering was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for passing a stopped school bus picking up children on West Franklin Street near Sugar Run Trail.

**May 17, 2018 – 0023 hours**

A private property accident was reported in the parking lot of a business on State Route 725. The driver at-fault failed to see a vehicle parked behind him while backing out of parking spot. The parties involved exchanged insurance information. Report taken.

**May 18, 2018 – 0823 hours**

An officer responded to Vemco Drive on the report of a dog running onto a resident's property. Greene County Animal Control was contacted after numerous attempts to make contact with the dog owner were unsuccessful. The canine was taken to the Greene County Animal Control shelter.

**May 18, 2018 – 1144 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Main Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 53-year old male from Springfield was cited into Court for Driving under Suspension. A passenger in the vehicle, a 33-year old male from Springfield was wanted on a warrant from the Clark County Sheriff's Department. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

**May 18, 2018 – 1338 hours**

An officer was dispatched to West Maple Street on the complaint of subject involved in door-to-door sales. The subject was located and told to cease his activity, and informed that he needs a solicitor permit for his sales.

**May 18, 2018 – 1753 hours**

A domestic dispute was reported on Sugar Maple Place. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. The parties were separated for the evening.
