May 20, 2018 – 0336 hours

Officers were dispatched to Ryder Court on a loud music complaint. Upon arrival officers learned that an assault had taken place. The suspect, a 49-year male resident had left the residence. The West Carrollton Police Department assisted in locating the suspect at a relative's home and arrested him. The suspect was charged with Assault and transported to the Greene County Jail.

May 20, 2018 – 1207 hours

An officer responded to Ridgeway Road where a male from Bellbrook had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

May 21, 2018 – 0150 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located an open garage door on Shore Drive. The homeowner was notified.

May 21, 2018 – 0753 hours

An officer was dispatched to Cabernet Way on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the homeowner had accidentally set off the alarm.

May 22, 2018 – 0732 hours

An officer responded to a business on State Route 725 where a female from Bellbrook had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.



May 22, 2018 – 1400 hours

A vehicle traveling northbound on North Belleview Drive lost control and struck a speed limit sign. The 26-year old female driver from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control.

May 22, 2108 – 1430 hours

A business owner on State Route 725 reported that he had bought a gift card on eBay but it was delivered to a wrong address. A report was taken and forwarded to eBay so that the complainant could be reimbursed for his monetary loss.

May 23, 2018 – 0210 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located an open door at a business at Bellbrook Plaza. A key holder was contacted and responded to the business to relock the door.

May 23, 2018 – 1535 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 27-year old driver from Vandalia did not have a valid driver's license. He was also wanted on a warrant from the Greene County Sheriff's Department. The driver was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Fictitious Registration, No Front License Plate, and No Seatbelt. The suspect was then taken into custody on the warrant and picked up by a Greene County Sheriff's Deputy.

May 24, 2018 – 1122 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on Lakeman Drive on the report of a disorderly customer. The suspect had left the scene before the officer's arrival but was located and stopped. Investigation revealed that a verbal agreement had occurred. The suspect was warned about her actions.



May 24, 2018 – 1418 hours

An officer was dispatched to Nedra Drive on the complaint of a subject involved in door-to-door sales. The subject was located and explained that he needs to obtain a solicitor permit. He was ordered to cease his activity.

May 25, 2018 – 1002 hours

Officers located several inoperable and unlicensed vehicles at a residence on Vemco Drive. The owner was issued a 10-day warning letter to correct the problem.

May 25, 2018 – 1356 hours

A burglary alarm activation was reported on Whites Drive. Officers made contact with the homeowner who advised he had accidentally set off the alarm.

May 25, 2018 – 1550 hours

A female arrived at the police department to report that she had been in a minor accident on private property on North Linda Drive. The parties involved in the accident had already exchanged insurance information. Report taken.
