June 10, 2018 – 0336 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a suspicious person on Ridgeway Road. Investigation led to the arrest of a 19-year old male from Xenia for Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle, Drug Abuse, and Possession of Criminal Tools. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.
