June 24, 2018 – 0159 hours

An assault was reported on Mill Run Lane. Investigation led to the arrest of a 37-year old male for Assault and Criminal Damaging and he was criminally trespassed from the property. A 32-year female was also charged with Assault and Criminal Damaging. Both subjects were cited into Xenia Municipal Court.

June 24, 2018 – 0905 hours

A resident on North East Street reported that a drone had been stolen out of his unlocked vehicle. There are no suspects at this time.

June 24, 2018 – 1140 hours

A wallet was found by a resident on Lower Hillside Drive. The wallet was returned to the owner who had reported that the wallet had been stolen from her unlocked vehicle on Ryder Court.

June 24, 2018 – 1300hrs

A loud party was reported on Ryder Court. The party was shut down but an intoxicated resident had threatened physical harm to a neighbor. The 31-year old male suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Menacing.

An officer located an occupied vehicle at Bellbrook Park after hours. The occupant of the vehicle was asleep and explained that he could not be in the park after he finally was awoken. The subject left the area.

Officers located an intoxicated subject with an open beer can on foot on North East Street. The subject was also found to be in possession of marijuana. The 25-year old subject from Spring Valley was taken into custody and charged with Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication, Drug Abuse, and Possession of an Open Container in Public. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.
