July 01, 2018 – 1949 hours

A complainant advised of poor living conditions for juvenile residents on W. Franklin St. The complainant was referred to the Greene County Children's Services Bureau for a follow-up.

July 01, 2018 – 2137 hours

The complainant advises he has received several unwanted texts to his phone from a female acquaintance. Bellbrook officers made contact with the female suspect and advised her of the complaint and to leave the complainant alone. She advised she would. The complainant also advised he will contact security at his work to prevent any further contact.

July 01, 2018 – 2207 hours

Officers responded into the area of Cedar Ct and Poston on a report of fireworks being set off. Officers made contact with several adults near the complaint and advised them they cannot shoot off fireworks within the city.

July 02, 2018 – 1156 hours

Officer was sent into the area of 4439 State Route 725 on a report of a possible intoxicated driver. The officer made contact with the driver inside a bar. The driver was not impaired and was not going to be driving from this location.

July 02, 2018 – 2124 hours

Officers responded to the canoe livery on a report of a disorderly subject. The complainant advised a black female was yelling at him as he drove from the area asking for her brother's



whereabouts. The female was advised his brother was not in the car. The female subject apologized to the complainant.

July 03, 2018 – 0116 hours

Officers responded to E. South St. on a report of domestic violence. The male half was under the influence of an illicit drug and began arguing with his wife. The male subject made threats to his wife and struck her in the face. Officers arrested the male subject and transported him to the Greene County Jail without incident.

July 03, 2018 – 1148 hours

A person was trying to make contact with a homeowner on Hillcrest Dr. The reporting person was afraid for her safety. An officer arrived and was able to make contact with the homeowner.

July 03, 2018 – 1310

A resident of Marcia Dr. advised officers that unknown subjects entered his vehicle and removed a drill. In the process of the theft, a hinge to the car door was damaged. No suspects at this time.

July 03, 2018 – 1658 hours

Officers sent into the area of Maxwell Dr on a suspicious person. Units were unable to locate the male subject.

July 03, 2018 – 1818 hours

Units responded to Washington Mill Dr to assist STPD units with a fight in progress. The subjects involved were gone upon arrival.



July 04, 2018 – 0108 hours

Units responded to W. Sudbury Ct. on a report of loud music. Upon units' arrival, they made contact with the resident. He was explained the issue and he turned down the music without issue.

July 04, 2018 – 0946

A Bellbrook officer responded to Shadowleaf Dr. on a fireworks complaint. The resident firing the fireworks spoke with the officer and advised he thought they were legal. He was advised they were not and to refrain from this activity in the future.

July 04, 2018 – 1720 hours

Officers responded to Ryder Ct on a neighbor dispute. A juvenile neighbor had placed a window screen in front of their security camera. Officers made contact with the juvenile and his guardians and advised to leave their neighbor and property alone.

July 04, 2018 – 2140 hours

The resident on Cabernet Way was advised to stop setting off fireworks. No further complaints.

July 04, 2018 – 2215 hours

A Bellbrook officer responded into the area of Walmart to assist STPD on a fireworks complaint. The subjects were gone upon arrival.

July 5, 2018 – 0425 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a loud muffler violation. Investigation revealed that the 17-year old male driver from Dayton was impaired. The driver was taken into custody and cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Defective Muffler, and a Probationary License Restriction violation.



July 6, 2018 – 1446 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a subject involved in door-to-door sales. The subject advised that he did not have a solicitor permit but his colleague from the same company did. The officer explained to the subject that each company employee needs their own permit, and ordered him to cease his activity.

July 6, 2018 – 1723 hours

An officer was dispatched to Birch Bark Court on the report of a suspicious vehicle parked in front of a residence. The officer spoke with the driver who advised that he was waiting for his employer to give him his paycheck at that location.

July 6, 2018 – 1828 hours

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Regent Park Drive. Contact with the occupant revealed that he was looking at a residence that is currently for sale.

July 7, 2018 – 0527 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for a registration violation. Investigation revealed that the 23-year old male did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Expired Registration.

July 7, 2018 – 1022 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department on a report of a theft in progress on Upper Bellbrook Road. The complainant advised that she had observed three male subjects placing items next to the guard rails near the bridge and then disappear under the bridge. The subjects were located and investigation revealed that the three men were contracted to work on the bridge. The information was relayed to the complainant.



July 7, 2018 – 2048 hours

An officer was dispatched to Maple Street on the report of a reckless motorcycle rider. Contact was made with the 20-year old male rider and he was advised of the complaint. The officer warned him about speeding and riding his motorcycle in a reckless manner.

A resident on Marcia Drive reported that when she arrived at her home she found several unlocked doors. Officers searched the interior of the home and did not find any signs of criminal activity. The complainant also advised that nothing appeared to have been taken from the home. Report taken.
