August 19, 2018 – 0152 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Main Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 51-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired. An open can of beer was found inside the vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a vehicle while under the Influence and Open Container. He was issued a warning for Failure to Dim Headlights.

August 19, 2018 – 0544 hours

A vehicle was stopped on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. The 18-year old male driver from Dayton had been arrested by the Sugarcreek Township Police Department for Possession of Drugs. A drug canine responded to the scene and alerted on the vehicle. Marijuana was located inside the vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and Two Headlights Required.

August 20, 2018 – 1534 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road near Moss Oak Trail. A dump truck stopped for a school bus on the inclined roadway rolled back and struck the vehicle behind it. The driver at-fault, a 22-year old male from Middletown was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control.

August 21, 2018 – 1701 hours

An officer was dispatched to South Main Street to assist on the report of a cat that was stuck in the engine compartment of the vehicle. The vehicle was moved to a local garage where the cat was freed.



August 21, 2018 – 2209 hours

Officers were dispatched on an alarm activation at a business on State Route 725. The interior was checked without any signs of criminal activity. A key holder was notified.

August 22, 2018 – 1100 hours

A gardener working at Petrikis Park on West Franklin Street at Vemco Drive located drug paraphernalia and a marijuana derivative from Colorado under some plants. The items were seized to be destroyed.

August 22, 2018 – 1935 hours

Officers responded to Periwinkle Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the homeowner accidentally set off the alarm.

August 23, 2018 – 1654 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street near North Regent Park Drive after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 30-year old male driver from Dayton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

August 24, 2018 – 2021 hours

A dog was reported running loose in the area of Shore Drive and Ridgeway Drive. The canine was located and returned to the caretaker who was issued a written warning for Dog at Large.
