August 26, 2018 – 0148 hours

Officers responded to a business on East Franklin Street on a complaint of disorderly persons. Investigation revealed a verbal argument had taken place between two men from Bellbrook. The men had left the business prior to the officers' arrival. Report taken.

August 26, 2018 – 0314 hours

Telephone harassment was reported on Pinegrove Drive. The complainant advised he had received a threatening phone call and text messages from a known subject. The suspect was contacted and ordered to cease all contact with the complainant. The report was referred to the Prosecutor's Office for review of charges.

August 26, 2018 – 1430 hours

A resident on Upper Hillside Drive reported he had locked his keys in his vehicle. An officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

August 26, 2018 – 2038 hours

An officer assisted the Greene County Sheriff's Department with an attempt to serve a warrant on Portage Path. The wanted person was not located.

August 26, 2018 – 2124 hours

Officers were dispatched to the construction site on Jacob Hills Court on a report of suspicious persons. Investigation revealed subjects were unloading construction materials.



August 28, 2018 – 0216 hours

An officer responded to South Lakeman Drive on the report of a barking dog. Contact was made with the owner who advised he had fallen asleep and accidentally left the dog outside. The subject apologized and took the dog inside the home.

August 28, 2018 – 1730 hours

A resident on Terrace Creek Drive reported that a box with copper pipes and wire had been stolen. There are no suspects at this time. Report taken.

August 29, 2018 – 2114 hours

An officer located a suspicious occupied vehicle in Bellbrook Park. Upon contact with the occupants the officer could smell an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Drug paraphernalia and drugs were found inside the vehicle. A 22-year old male from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

August 30, 2018 – 0943 hours

A single vehicle traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street near Little Sugarcreek Road where a vehicle had struck a utility pole. Investigation revealed that the driver had experienced a medical emergency that led to the accident. The driver was transported to the hospital.

August 31, 2018 – 1808 hours

A resident on Lakeman Drive reported that he had locked his keys in his vehicle. An officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

September 1, 2018 – 1028 hours

An officer was dispatched to Wentworth Village Drive on a stalking complaint. The complainant advised that a subject known to her continues to contact her through phone calls, e-mails, and by driving through her street. The suspect was contacted and ordered to cease all contact with the complainant.



September 1, 2018 – 2309 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on East Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 33-year old male driver from Beavercreek did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

September 1, 2018 – 2320 hours

A traffic accident was reported on North Main Street. A vehicle turning from High Street onto North Main Street struck a stopped vehicle. The 16-year old female driver at-fault was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Yield at an Intersection.
