September 10, 2018 – 0353 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a suspicious vehicle parked at Bill Yeck Park. Marijuana and drug paraphernalia were located inside the car. The officer remained on scene until no longer needed.

September 10, 2018 – 1113 hours

A wallet was found in a business parking lot on West Franklin Street. The owner was located and the property returned.

September 11, 2018 – 1440 hours

A resident on Rosecrest Drive reported that he had been the victim of a fraud. The subject reported being contacted someone who claimed to be an employee from the Social Security Office. The victim was told that his identity was being used by a wanted person and to withdraw money from his bank to buy Google Play cards before his accounts would be frozen by the Social Security Office. The victim was then told to give the caller the Google Play cards' account numbers. The victim lost \$1,400.00 in the process. Report taken to be forwarded to Google's Fraud Department.

September 11, 2018 – 1925 hours

An officer responded to Ryder Court where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.



September 12, 2018 – 0022 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 47-year old male driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and issued a warning for Two Headlights Required.

September 12, 2018 – 1841 hours

An officer assisted the Bellbrook Fire Department with an oven fire on Mill Run Lane. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

September 13, 2018 – 1352 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the 35-year old male driver from Spring Valley did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

September 14, 2018 – 2210 hours

A resident on Lynlee Drive locked his keys in his vehicle. An officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

A traffic accident was reported on East Franklin Street. A subject traveling eastbound did not slow down in time for a vehicle stopped to turn onto Washington Mill Road, resulting in a collision. The driver at-fault, a 16-year old male from Dayton was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Maintain Assured Clear Distance Ahead.
