### **September 23, 2018 – 0135 hours**

A loud music complaint was reported on Poston Drive. Investigation revealed a wedding party was in progress. The homeowner was informed of the complaint and turned down the music.

### **September 23, 2018 – 1334 hours**

An unwanted person was reported on West Maple Street. Investigation revealed a verbal dispute had occurred and a 34-year old female from Bellbrook was told to leave the residence.

### **September 23, 2018 – 2312 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle because the driver was known not to have a valid driver's license. The 22-year old driver from Miamisburg was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

### **September 24, 2018 – 1349 hours**

A vehicle was stopped on North Main Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 41-year old male from Waynesville was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

### **September 24, 2018 – 1550 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 on the report of a disorderly subject causing a disturbance. A customer was yelling and cursing at an acquaintance inside the business. The suspect left before officers arrived. Neither the business or suspect's acquaintance wanted to file criminal charges.



**September 24, 2018 – 2015 hours**

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a domestic dispute in progress on Graf Mill Road. A male subject was detained and officers cleared the scene.

**September 25, 2018 – 1341 hours**

Officers were dispatched to South East Street for a welfare check after a mother had been unsuccessful in making contact with her son. Upon arrival no one was at the residence. A phone call to the son was made. He later returned the call and advised he was okay and would contact his mother.

A complaint of an unruly 11-year old juvenile was received on Cabernet Way. Officers spoke to the juvenile at length about needing to follow his parents' rules and to be obedient. The boy calmed down and apologized to his parents for his behavior.

**September 26, 2018 – 1532 hours**

An officer was dispatched to a business parking lot on West Franklin Street where a female from Wilmington had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry.

An unwanted subject was reported at a business on State Route 725. The subject was asking patrons for cigarettes and sips of their drinks. Officers ordered to subject to leave the business.
