October 7, 2018 – 0258 hours

Officers were dispatched on the report of a suspicious person at a business on State Route 725. The complainant advised that while she was inside of her parked car, a male knocked on her window and asked the female to roll it down and exit the vehicle. The suspect, a 36-year old male from Waynesville was located and found to be highly intoxicated. The subject had been warned a month earlier about being disorderly and intoxicated in public. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication.
