**October 14, 2018 – 0851 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 on the report of a disorderly subject. The business wanted to male criminally trespassed from their property. The subject seemed disoriented and was transported to Miami Valley South Hospital. He was issued a warning for Criminal Trespassing.

**October 15, 2018 – 0742 hours**

A report of a male subject harassing customers at a business on State Route 725 was received. Officers made contact with the subject in question who was transported to his home in Sugarcreek Township.

**October 16, 2018 – 0727 hours**

A female from Fairborn locked her keys in her vehicle on Lakeview Drive. An officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

**October 16, 2018 – 0927 hours**

Officers were dispatched to the downtown area to locate a 15-year old male who had walked away from school. The subject was located and transported back to the school on East South Street. The matter was handled by the school after the student was returned.

**October 17, 2018 – 1008 hours**

A credit card was found at Bellbrook Plaza. The owner was located and picked up the property from the police department later that day.

**October 17, 2018 – 1951 hours**

An unwanted subject was reported at a business on State Route 725. A short while later a complaint of an unwanted subject was received from a nearby business. The suspect, a 23-year old male from Sugarcreek Township was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication. He was trespassed from both businesses. The suspect was later released to a relative.



**October 18, 2018 – 1643 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Little Sugarcreek Road after several calls about a male walking in traffic were received. Contact was made with a 23-year old male who was found to be intoxicated. The subject was arrested, charged with Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication and transported to the Greene County Jail.

**October 18, 2018 – 1837 hours**

A suspicious vehicle was reported in the area of Lynlee Drive and Possum Run Road. An officer located the vehicle and made contact with two subjects from Dayton. They advised they work for a construction company and were contacting existing customers. They were told they needed to obtain a solicitor permit if they were planning on new sales contacts.

**October 18, 2018 – 2215 hours**

An officer was dispatched to a business on West Franklin Street where a male from Xenia had locked his vehicles in his car which was running. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

**October 19, 2018 – 1119 hours**

Officers assisted the Xenia Police Department with locating a shoplifting suspect. The 32-year old female from Marcia Drive was located at her home and arrested. A Xenia officer responded and took custody of the female.

**October 19, 2018 – 1806 hours**

A domestic dispute between adult siblings was reported on Lakeview Drive. The dispute had been verbal in nature without any physical violence. Report taken.

**October 19, 2018 – 1918 hours**

A car key was found on West Franklin Street and turned over to the police department. A discount card from a business on State Route 725 was also on the key ring. An officer responded to the business and found out who the owner was by having the discount card



traced. The officer responded to Ridgeway Road and returned the car key and discount card to the owner.

**October 20, 2018 – 1250 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Bellemeade Drive on the report of a domestic dispute between 4 family members. No violence had occurred but the complainant and her mother and husband left the residence and went to stay at a hotel until they were leaving for Arizona two days later. The male resident remained on Bellemeade Drive.

**October 20, 2018 – 1905 hours**

A traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street. A vehicle swerved into oncoming traffic to avoid a tree in the roadway. The car was struck by an oncoming vehicle. A 16-year old male driver from Dayton was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Control.
