October 28, 2018 – 2311 hours

An officer observed a suspicious vehicle parked behind a business on State Route 725. Contact with the driver revealed that he was there to pick up a friend.

A burglary alarm was reported on North Regent Park Drive. Contact with the alarm company revealed the alarm was caused by an equipment problem. Report taken.

October 29, 2018 – 1603 hours

A theft was reported on Clearview Court. Several pieces of jewelry were stolen from the complainant's home. The case is under investigation.

A wallet was found on North Main Street and turned into the police department. An officer responded to the owner's residence on Pavilion lane and returned the property to her.

An officer responded to Upper Hillside Drive on a burglary alarm activation. A construction worker at the residence told the officer he had accidentally set off the alarm.

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a vehicle that was found with the keys in the ignition at the Sugarcreek MetroPark. Contact with the owner who resides on West Sudbury Drive revealed that the vehicle had a dead battery and he was picking up the vehicle during daylight hours.

A traffic accident involving a school and a garbage truck was reported on Cabernet Way. The school bus tried to pass the garbage truck that was stopped for trash pick up. As the school bus was passing the truck it struck its' front bumper. There were no injuries. The driver at-fault was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Improper Passing to the Left.

An officer was dispatched to the intersection on the report of a disabled vehicle. The officer arrived on scene and helped the owner move the vehicle out of the roadway. A tow truck was called to pick up the vehicle.
