**November 4, 2018 – 0812 hours**

A resident on Chelsea Drive reported receiving harassing text messages from a female in North Carolina. The suspect was contacted and ordered to cease any communication with the complainant.

**November 4, 2018 – 1251 hours**

Officers responded to a business on East Franklin Street on the report of an intoxicated subject with a gun. Contact with the 59-year old male suspect from Xenia revealed that he was impaired but did not have a gun on his person or in his vehicle. A relative was called to pick up the subject.

An officer was dispatched to Bellemeade Drive on the report of a garage door that had been open for hours. The residence was checked. No signs of criminal activity were observed. The homeowner was contacted and the garage door closed.

Investigation led to the arrest of a 53-year old female from Bellbrook for Disorderly Conduct and Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court and criminally trespassed from the business.

**November 9, 2018 – 1748 hours**

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a disabled vehicle on I-675. A subject in the vehicle was wanted on a warrant and taken into custody. The officer stood by until no longer needed.



**November 9, 2018 – 2115 hours**

Officers responded to West Franklin Street to assist the Centerville Police Department with a warrant arrest. A 37-year old male from Bellbrook was taken into custody and turned over to a Centerville Police Officer.

**November 10, 2018 – 0228 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Vemco Drive on the report of a suspicious vehicle. Officers located the vehicle parked in the middle of the roadway with the driver sleeping behind the wheel. Investigation led to the arrest of a 38-year old male from Dayton for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Drug Abuse, and Possession of an Open Container.

A burglary alarm was reported at a business on East Franklin Street. Officers checked the building which was found to be secure. False alarm.
