**December 23, 2018 – 0159 hours**

Report of gunshots in the area of Dane Lane. Officers checked the area and did not locate any problem.

**December 23, 2018 – 2002 hours**

Officer responded to a resident on Little Sugarcreek Road who needed help with a cordless phone. Aid was rendered as was much appreciated by the resident.

**December 24, 2018 – 0215 hours**

A routine traffic stop on West Franklin Street at Little Sugarcreek Road for a speed violation led to additional charges. The officer noticed a marijuana odor emanating from the vehicle which led to the discovery of marijuana and associated paraphernalia. Driver was cited for speed, possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia.

Officers responded to Hillrise Circle on an alarm. Upon arrival, the residence was found secure. Owners were notified.

**December 26, 2018 – 1522 hours**

A resident of Polo Trace Court contacted BPD in our lobby about a possible fraud attempt on his identity. The resident was not out any money and his bank was made aware of the incident.

**December 27, 2018 – 0215 hours**

Female officer was asked by the Sugarcreek Township Police Department to assist with a female arrestee. The arrestee had been drinking and the officer assisted with the search of her person before further processing by the Sugarcreek Township Police Department could be performed.



**December 27, 2018 – 0257 hours**

Female officer was requested by the Sugarcreek Township Police Department to assist with another pat down search of a female detainee. The search was performed without incident.

**December 27, 2018 – 0934 hours**

Officer responded to a burglary alarm on Barnett Drive. The residence was found to be secure and no suspicious activity was found.
