April 7, 2019 – 0118 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the 42-year old male driver from Xenia did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Court for Driving under Suspension.

April 7, 2019 – 1933 hours

Officers were dispatched to West Maple Street for a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the homeowner had accidentally set off the alarm.

April 8, 2019 – 0629 hours

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Sable Ridge Drive. The vehicle was located and contact with the driver revealed that she was a contractor working in the area for several days.

April 8, 2019 – 1918 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on East Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Upon contact with the 25-year old male driver from Franklin the officer could smell an odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle. The vehicle was searched with the owner's consent, and drug paraphernalia was found. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

April 9, 2019 – 1131 hours

A resident on Shadowleaf Court reported that he had found a dog and was keeping it in his garage until it could be picked up. Greene County Animal Control retrieved the dog and was later claimed by its' owner.

April 9, 2019 – 1435 hours

A resident on Portage path reported that an unknown subject had opened a cellular phone account in her name. The complainant was not out of any money and the account had been closed. Report taken.



April 11, 2019 – 1050 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a vehicle in the middle of the parking lot of Bellbrook Plaza, blocking traffic. Contact was made with the owner who moved the vehicle.

April 11, 2019 – 1139 hours

Officers were dispatched to Upper Bellbrook Road where an infant was left in a locked car without a parent nearby. The mother could not be located but returned to the vehicle approximately 25 minutes after the complaint was received. The mother was sternly warned and advised that she would be arrested for Child Endangerment and transported to the jail if she would commit the same offense again. The child was okay.

April 11, 2019 – 1401 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported that a stolen check had been passed at their business. The case is under investigation.

April 12, 2019 – 2218 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle after observing a female known to have no valid driver's license, driving on Wilmington-Dayton Road. The suspect, a 31-year old female from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

April 13, 2019 – 1109 hours

A vehicle that had been pursued by the Greene County Sheriff's Office was observed by an officer entering the City at East Franklin Street. The driver failed to comply with the officer's order to stop. The pursuit was terminated off shortly after. The suspect was later apprehended by the Sugarcreek Township Police Department.
