**January 19, 2020 – 1058 hours**

Officer responded to a residence on Lakeview for an intrusion alarm. The exterior and interior of the home were checked. False alarm.

**January 19, 2020 – 1348 hours**

Officers responded to a residence on North Main Street regarding a domestic dispute. Contact was made with the homeowners and the investigation revealed they were having an argument. There were no indications of physical or verbal abuse.

**January 19, 2020 – 1452 hours**

Officer responded to a residence on Eckworth Drive for an intrusion alarm. Officer checked the residence and found no signs of entry. False alarm.

**January 19, 2020 – 2034 hours**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Sugar Maple Place and River Birch Court reference a suspicious vehicle. Officers located two people in the vehicle with the engine running and the headlights on. Officers spoke with the individuals and explained the suspicious nature of parking in this area after dark and advised them to leave the area.

A Bellbrook Officer took custody of the narcotics and issued a summons for the same. The individual was taken into custody by probation officers for the probation violation.

Officers were dispatched to a residence on Hess Road regarding a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed that two parties were having an argument. There were no indications of physical or verbal abuse.

**January 24, 2020 – 1015 hours**

Officers responded to a business on State Route 725 for reports of a fire. Officers assisted in evacuating the business while Fire crews responded.

Officers were dispatched to a residence on Bledsoe Drive for a welfare check. Investigation revealed that a resident had threatened a family member with violence. That individual was taken into custody for Domestic Violence by Threats.

Officer responded to a building on East Franklin Street for an intrusion alarm. The exterior of the building was checked and no criminal activity was found. False alarm.

**January 25, 2020 – 1800 hours**

Officer observed a vehicle being driven by a female that matched the description of a wanted person. Officer made contact and verified that the female had two active warrants out of neighboring jurisdictions. She was taken into custody on those warrants and issued a citation for driving under suspension.
